

Year End Award(s) will be withheld from any owner and/or exhibitor for failure to pay when due any obligation owed to TPEA.

YEAR-END AWARDS

1. To be eligible for Year-End Awards, the exhibitor or owner of the horse must work a total of (2) segments during the year. Segments are defined as follows: All halter classes; All English classes; 2 Year Old snaffle bit Western Pleasure thru Trail; Ranch Horse thru Speed classes. Another person may work for the exhibitor or owner but it is their responsibility to log names and times on the sign-in sheet. If this work is not completed, the next horse eligible will receive the High Point Year-End Award(s). These rules coincide with other Show Rules requirements.
2. High Point Halter Year-End Awards will be presented to the Stallion, Mare, and Gelding horse with the most overall class points.
3. High Point Performance Year-End Awards will be given to the Jr. Stallion, Sr. Stallion, Jr. Mare, Sr. Mare, Jr. Gelding, and Sr. Gelding with the most performance points.
4. High Point Overall Year-End Awards will be given to the Jr. Stallion, Sr. Stallion, Jr. Mare, Sr. Mare, Jr. Gelding, and Sr. Gelding with the most overall points. (Horses must have at least ten halter or color points, and at least ten performance points in two different events.)
5. The Baker Award will be presented to the Overall High Point Open Horse that has accumulated the most points. The owner will receive a belt buckle and a traveling trophy to keep for the year. (Horses must have at least 10 halter or color points and at least 10 performance points in two different events in open classes)
6. High Point & Reserve High Point will be given in these divisions: Novice Amateur, Amateur, Amateur Select, Youth 59 Walk-Trot, Youth 13 & Under, and Youth 14-18. Halter and color points do count. The High Point award winners will receive belt buckles. Reserve High Point winners will receive smaller awards.
7. High Point Awards will be given in each class if eligibility has been met. Awards may be combined if the horse has won more than one.
8. High point Out-of-State Exhibitor/Owner will be awarded.
9. The Youth Sportsmanship Award will be given at the Awards Banquet. Voting will be done by secret ballot by the Youth.
10. The O. H. Crew Memorial Sportsmanship Open and Amateur Awards will be given at the Awards Banquet. Voting will be done by secret ballot. Amateurs vote for amateurs and everyone votes for open.
