

ELIGIBILITY FOR YEAR END AWARDS

To be eligible for TPEA Year-End Awards, the owner and exhibitor must be a member of TPEA. If the horse is sold, the Open points will transfer only if the new owner is a member of TPEA. In case of joint ownership, all owners must be members of TPEA. Ownership shall be determined by PHBA.

To be eligible for TPEA Youth, Amateur, Select Amateur, and Novice Amateur Year End Awards, the exhibitor and owner must be members of TPEA.

**** IN ADDITION, WORK SEGMENTS AS LISTED HERE ARE REQUIRED. ****

To be eligible for Year End Awards, two (2) segments must be worked for each horse during the year. It is the volunteer's responsibility to accurately log in the work segment book at the office and be verified by the office staff or show chairman in order for those segments to be counted.

Segments are defined as follows:

*Halter *English *Western through Horsemanship *Trail *Ranch Horse through Speed
If work segments are not completed, the next eligible horse will receive the Year End Award(s).

Year End Awards will be withheld from any owner and/exhibitor for failure to pay when due any obligation owed to TPEA. NO EXCEPTIONS!

YEAR END AWARDS

1. A Year End Overall High Point Halter award will be presented to the Stallion, Mare, and Gelding with the most overall halter points in halter classes that recognize multiple age groups.
3. High Point Performance Year-End Awards through 5th place will be given in both Junior Horse and Senior Horse open divisions based on points in all classes.
4. A special All Around High Point and All Around Reserve High Point Award will be presented to horses that have earned at least 10 points in any halter class and/or color and at least 10 performance points in two different events in open classes.
5. Year End High Point Awards through 5th place will be given in these divisions: Amateur, Amateur Select, Novice Amateur, Youth 5-9, Youth 13 & Under, Youth 14-18, and Novice Youth.
6. Year End High Point Awards through 3rd place will be given in each individual class. All awards require a minimum of 10 points. Exception: no point requirements for weanlings, 2 yr old snaffle bit, longe line.

Awards will be combined if the horse has won more than one.
